God works through Stephen Ministers to plant a seed of hope and healing in a person whose life is disrupted because of some crisis or tragedy. In order for Stephen Ministers to be effective, they are required to receive 50 hours of group training by a Stephen Leader. If anybody has ever told you that you are a great listener, that you helped make them feel better, and/or that your presence is comforting, then you should strongly consider becoming a Stephen Minister in the future.

## Children's Activities

**Kids JAM** (children's choir): Meets from 5:15PM-6:00PM on the Second Floor in the Music Suite (choir room) for 1st-5th grade and Room 200 for Pre-K & Kindergarten. Children in KidsJAM will have opportunities throughout the year to sing for the church and participate in seasonal programs. The children will sing in worship on February 11, March 25, and for Children's Sunday on May 6. Look for more details about upcoming events in the church newsletter.

**Children's Ministry activities** are from 6:30PM-7:30PM for children in Pre-K - 5th Grade. The children will gather as a large group in Room 306, before breaking into small groups by grade. Their time together will include games, mission focused activities, and small group discussion for Grades 1-5, and music, activities, and playground time for Kindergarten and Pre-K.

## Youth Small Groups

This weekly event is for Middle and High School Students. Students will meet in the Youth Room to participate in fellowship, food, games, and Bible study. **Small groups** are divided by grade and gender. Dinner in the Fellowship Hall starts at 5:30PM. The Youth Room will open at 6:00PM. Groups divide up at 6:15PM for games, and Bible study will begin at 7:00PM. The cost for a pizza dinner is \$2.00 and students are dismissed at 8:00PM.

Our church building fills up on Wednesday nights, with almost every room being utilized. Class sizes and locations are still being determined. Check the information displays around the church for a list of class locations.
